Accreditation

Application for CME credit has been filed with the American Academy of Family Physicians and determination of credit is pending. AAFP Prescribed credit is accepted by the American Medical Association as equivalent to AMA PRA Category 1 credit toward the AMA Physician's Recognition Award. CME activities approved for AAFP credit are recognized by the AOA as equivalent to AOA Category 2 credit.

Registration

The full registration fee includes an SCAFP name badge for access to the Exhibit Hall, all continental breakfasts and refreshment breaks, general session continuing medical education presentations, general sessions lecture materials, a ticket to the Social Distancing Luncheon and Installation Luncheon. CONFERENCE SAFETY PROTOCOLS

5. Social distancing will be implemented by design at all SCAFP events.

6. The Hilton Resort has implemented protocols which will be followed for cleaning meeting rooms and disinfecting bathrooms/other common areas on the property. To successfully complete the assessment, 80% of the questions must be answered correctly.
